Easter Duty

After a Catholic has been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter Season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. This obligation may be fulfilled between February 14 (First Sunday of Lent) and May 22 (Trinity Sunday).

The following should also be noted:

**Reconciliation:* Catholics are bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year (Canon 989).

**Other Fridays of the year:* Catholics should be reminded that all other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance, in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ.

**Obligation:* The obligation which we have as members of the Church to do penance is a serious one. Furthermore, the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially", the penitential days specified by the Church is a serious one.

**While on one should hold himself or herself lightly excused, one should not become unduly scrupulous. Failure to observe individual days of penance is less*

serious that the failure to observe and penitential days at all or substantial number of such days.

Fasting

In the name of peace and in union with the Bishops of our country, the faithful of the Diocese are invited to add voluntary fasting to the practice of penance during the Fridays of the year. Together with works of charity and service toward our neighbors, this practice would become a sign of commitment to conservation, reconciliation and peace. (The Challenge of Peace, Art. 298)
