Ash Wednesday is February 10th. Ash Wednesday is one of the most popular and important holy days in the liturgical calendar. Ash Wednesday opens Lent, a season of fasting and prayer. Ash Wednesday takes place 46 days before Easter Sunday, and is chiefly observed by Catholics, although many other Christians observe it too. Ash Wednesday comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting. The practice includes the wearing of ashes on the head. The ashes symbolize the dust from which God made us.

#### Information

In order to keep the information in our Parish Data System current, please let us know if there were any etc. If someone you care for has been placed in a facility, or might be requesting other information. Let us know by mail, phone, or by jotting a note and sending it to the office in the collection basket. This way we can keep the records updated. It is the practice of Corpus Christi that no private information is sold or distributed. Names, numbers and addresses are kept private and not shared.

#### Easter Duty

After a Catholic has been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter Season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year.

This obligation may be fulfilled between February 14 (First Sunday of Lent) and May 22 (Trinity Sunday).

#### The following should also be noted:

*\*Reconciliation:* Catholics are bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year (Canon 989).

*\*Other Fridays of the year:* Catholics should be reminded that all other Fridays of the year remain as days of penance, in prayerful remembrance of the Passion of Jesus Christ.

*\*Obligation:* The obligation which we have as members of the Church to do penance is a serious one. Furthermore, the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially", the penitential days specified by the Church is a serious one.

*\*While on one should hold himself or herself lightly excused, one should not become unduly scrupulous. Failure to observe individual days of penance is less serious than the failure to observe and penitential days at all or substantial number of such days.*

#### Do you Feel God is Calling You
