May Crowning

Nex Sunday May 12th after the 9:30 Mass and before the 11:00 Mass we will take time to crown the statue of Our Lady in the area across the street. We keep the tradition of Crowning Mary Queen of May and of Our Lives.

May is such a beautiful month. The whole month is dedicated to our Blessed Lady, Mother of God. The pious practice of honoring the Blessed Virgin Mary during the entire month of May has been especially recommended by many Popes.

Some devotions to Mother Mary for the Month of May

1. Recite the Regina Coeli (during the Paschal Season) or Angelus (other days of the year) daily.
2. Recite the Rosary daily as a family. Remember to meditate on each mystery and to pray with all your heart and mind.
3. Recite the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary also known as the Litany of Loreto.
4. Celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima on May 13th. You can pray a Novena to Our Lady of Fatima in preparation for her Feast.
5. Visit a Marian Shrine as a pilgrimage.
6. Prepare a Marian Altar in your home for the "Queen of May" with pictures/statues of Mother Mary and many flowers.
7. Celebrate May Crowning at your church or in your house by crowning a statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary with a crown of flowers.
