Monday, November 11th, Saint Martin of Tours, Bishop

Saint Martin the Merciful, Bishop of Tours, was born at Sabaria in Pannonia (modern Hungary) in 316. Since his father was a Roman officer, he also was obliged to serve in the army. Martin did so unwillingly, for he considered himself a soldier of Christ,



though he was still a catechumen. At the gates of Amiens, he saw a beggar shivering in the severe winter cold, so he cut his cloak in two and gave half to the beggar. That night, the Lord Jesus Christ appeared to the saint wearing Martin's cloak. He heard the Savior say to the angels surrounding Him, "Martin is only a catechumen, but he has clothed Me with this garment." The saint was baptized soon after this, and reluctantly remained in the army.

Special Triptych

God's Providence watches over us and allows us to live a great and important moments in the Church, in the parish, in the family and our lives. The year 2020 is the year of the Great Jubilee, exactly on May 18th; it will be the 100th anniversary of the birth of Great John Paul II.
