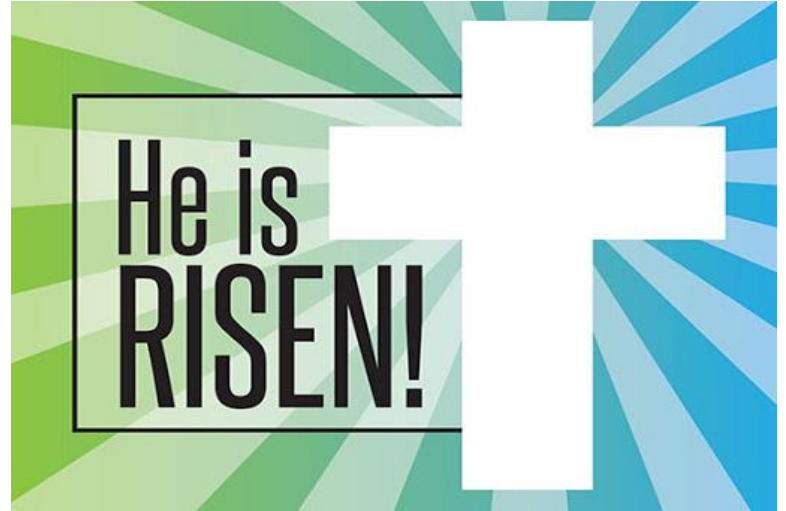
Only registered and participating parishioners will be issued a Letter of Recommendation. Letters cannot be issued to non-parishioners
