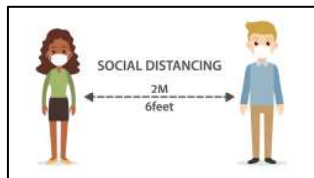

**Sanctuary Lamps**



Corpus Christi is experiencing a variation in practices. For several years there have been many Mass intention openings, people seem to be requesting more Masses. For years Sanctuary Lamps have always had intentions. This year our Sanctuary Lamps have many open intentions. Please use this opportunity to honor or remember a cherished individual or event. Call the office for openings. The sanctuary lamp, also called a chancel lamp, is placed before the tabernacle in a Roman Catholic Church as a sign that the Blessed Sacrament is reserved or stored within.

**Ringling the Bells**

The primary purpose of ringing the church bells in today’s world times is to remind worshippers to gather for a church service about to begin. In Christianity, the bell is said to represent the “voice of God”. Traditionally, they are used to not only call worshippers to the church for a communal service, but also to announce times of daily prayer. Before modern communications, church bells were a common way to call the community together for all purposes, both sacred and secular. Here at Corpus Christi Church we own three bells. The bell of Saint Anthony (1,500 lbs.) is our largest bell, the bell of Saint Francis ( 1,000 lbs.) and the smallest of Saint Hyacinth (750 lbs.) One of our loyal parishioners, Martin Ederer maintains our bells. We thank him for his efforts in our behalf. We are offering to anyone interested, a special opportunity to ring one of our tree bells, and call our parishioners to Mass. This happens 5 minutes before Mass. So if you are able to climb 2 flights of steps and would like to pull on the ropes, and become a members of our Bell Club, please see one of our ushers, or call the office at 716-896-1050.
