All Souls Candles



Corpus Christi has established a tradition that we have practiced for about the last ten years. On Sunday October, 31, 2021, we will be selling votive candles that you can place on the altar rail with your loved ones' name or names written on them. This is a special way to pray and to remember them

during the time we use to pray and remember those who have passed. Candles will be \$5, either you or someone in the back of the church will write their names on them and you can light them when they are placed on the altar rail. And please remember to include those who have no one to pray for them in your prayers.

The sanctuary lamp, also called a chancel lamp, is placed before the tabernacle in a Roman Catholic Church as a sign that the Blessed Sacrament is reserved or stored within.


"Come and See" Vocational Retreat for Men
