**November 1st, All Saints**

All Saints' Day is a solemn holy day of the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven. Although millions, or even billions of people may already be saints, All Saints' Day observances tend to focus on known saints -that is those recognized in the canon of the saints by the Catholic Church.

**November 2th,  
The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed**

"On this day is observed the commemoration of the faithful departed, in which our common and pious Mother the Church, immediately after having endeavored to celebrate by worthy praise all her children who already rejoice in heaven, strives to aid by her powerful intercession with Christ, her Lord and Spouse, all those who still groan in purgatory, so that they may join as soon as possible the inhabitants of the heavenly city." —Roman Martyrology

**Activities for All Souls Day:**

Visit the cemetery. Some cemeteries have special sections for infants, and you might wish to pray especially here.

Go to Mass. Find out the schedule of Masses for the day. Pray the following:

**Let perpetual light shine upon them,  
with your Saints forever, for you are merciful.  
Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord,  
and let perpetual light shine upon them,

Amen.**

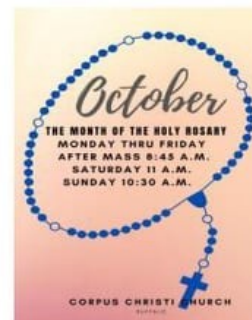
