The presentation will occur in the Canisius High School Auditorium, 1180 Delaware Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14209. This is the fifth lecture in the Catherine M. and Paul W. Beltz Lecture Series of the Church on Fire: Stay With Us!

Sister Helen Prejean is known around the world for her tireless work against the death penalty. She has been instrumental in sparking national dialogue on capital punishment and in shaping the Catholic Church's vigorous opposition to all executions. In her virtual presentation on River of Fire, Sr. Helen will talk about her childhood, convent and early ministry experiences where she worked with the African-American poor who helped her understand what white privilege and institutional racism is.
