Reflection from Monday's Mass

"Refuse no one the good on which he has
a claim, when it is in your power to do it
for him. Say not to your neighbor, "Go,
and come again. Tomorrow I will give,"
when you can give him at once. Plot no
evil against your neighbor, against one
who lives at peace with you. Quarrel not
with a man without cause, with one who
has done you no harm. Envy not the
lawless man and choose none of his ways:

To the LORD the perverse one is an
abomination, but with the upright in his
friendship. The curse of the LORD is on the
house of the wicked, but the dwelling of
the just he blesses; When dealing with
the arrogant, he is stern, but to the
humble he shows kindness."
