Pope Gregory III established November 1 as All Saints’ Day, also known as All Hallows’ Day, a day to honor all saints of the church that have attained heaven.

### Michigan Proposal 3,

#### Right to Reproductive Freedom Initiative

If this proposal passes in Michigan, it would allow the killing of unborn babies in abortions through all nine months of pregnancy and allow anyone, including people without any medical training, to “assist” with an abortion, *according to Citizens to Support Michigan Women and Children*.

Also, at the present time, Michigan law requires parents to consent for their underage child to have basically any medical procedure, from having their tonsils removed to an abortion. However, the amendment would create an exemption for abortion, making it so a girl as young as 12 can have an abortion without her parents’ knowledge or consent. If this Proposal were to pass in Michigan, it would make it so much easier for it to be passed in other states.
