Disputa del Santissimo Sacramento

The Disputation of the Holy Sacrament, or Disputa, is a painting by the Italian Renaissance artist Raphael. It was painted between 1509 and 1510 as the first part of Raphael's commission to decorate with frescoes the rooms that are now known as the Stanze de Raffaello, in the Apostolic Palace in the Vatican. We have a replica of Disputa del Santissimo Sacramento above our Main Altar at Corpus Christi Church.

At the Top Center is God the Father. Seated below God the Father is Jesus seated on His Throne with the Holy Spirit in the form of a Dove just below Him. To the near right of Jesus is the Blessed Virgin Mary, Daughter to the Father, Mother to the Son, and Spouse of the Holy Spirit. Seated close to Jesus' left hand is St. John the Baptist.

The twelve figures from left to right on either side of the Central Cluster are: St. Peter, Adam, St. John the Evangelist, David, St. Lawrence, and Joshua. Then there are four angels with books in the center of the twelve figures representing the four gospels, which are the Gospel of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Continuing across we start with Judas Maccabeus, St. Stephen, Moses, St. James the Lesser, Abraham, and the far right ends with St. Paul. We are so blessed to have a replica of this beautiful work of art right here at Corpus Christi, and we must remember that all these Saints are here with us during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

Catechism of the Catholic Church

2270 Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person – among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life.

"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you." (Jer 1:5)

"My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately wrought in the depths of the earth." (Ps 139:15)

2271 Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or a means, is gravely contrary to the moral law:

"You shall not kill the embryo by abortion and shall not cause the newborn to perish." (Didache 2,2)

"God, the Lord of life, has entrusted to men the noble mission of safeguarding life, and men must carry it out in a manner worthy of themselves. Life must be protected with the utmost care from the moment of conception: abortion and infanticide are abominable crimes." (GS 51 & 3)
