invites us to a completely different attitude, to an attitude of being worthy of Christ. What do we mean by that? Namely, that we are to bring forth the fruits of conversion, as we read in the earlier passage of Matthew's version of the Gospel.

That is why conversion is so important in our lives. Until man adopts the attitude of constant conversion in his life, he will not be able to open himself to a deep relationship with Jesus. He will constantly err, trying to arrange his life in his own way, which in turn will lead him to many disappointments and even frustration. Conversion also involves accepting oneself in a concrete situation, not hiding one's spiritual condition from oneself, and even more so from God, one's spiritual condition. Yes, it generates resistance in man because how can I admit that in fact I am perhaps even in a very deplorable spiritual condition. Nevertheless, striving to stand in the truth about oneself makes man slowly open up to the relationship with God and begins to really carry the cross of his life in imitation of Jesus. The fruit of personal conversion is also the ability to listen authentically to God's voice and to arrange one's life according to this voice.

## HUMILITY OF HEART

By Father Cajetan Mary da Bergamo

**46.** “However upright we may be, we must never be scandalized nor amazed at the conduct of evil-doers, nor consider ourselves better than they, because we do not know what is ordained for them or for us in the supreme dispositions of God, Who doth great things and unsearchable and wonderful things without number as we read in the Book of Job.

When Zaccheus thought only of usury and oppressing the poor, when Magdalen filled Jerusalem with scandal, when Paul cursed and persecuted the Christian religion, who would have imagined that they would ever have become Saints? And on the other hand, who would have believed Solomon, the oracle of divine wisdom, would die in the midst of wantonness and idols? That Judas, one of the Apostles, would betray the Divine Master and then give himself up to despair? Or that many holy men, advanced in sanctity, would have become apostates? These are examples which should make us tremble of the judgment and mercy of God as we read in the Psalms and as Mary exclaims in the Book of Luke.

Every Saint can in a moment become a sinner if he is vain of his sanctity; and a sinner can as quickly become a Saint—if he is contrite and humbles himself for his sin.”
