FIRST THURSDAYS DEVOTION

The First Thursdays Devotion, also called the **Act of Reparation to the Wounds of Jesus and to the Holy Eucharist** is a Catholic tradition to offer acts of reparation.

Eucharistic adoration during a Holy Hour on Thursdays was part of the revelations reported by Margaret Mary Alacoque. Pope Pius VI granted a plenary indulgence for those who would visit the Blessed Sacrament on the first Thursday of the month.

According to pious legend, Saint Bernard asked Jesus which was his greatest unrecorded suffering and the wound that inflicted the most pain on him in Calvary. Jesus answered: 'I had on my shoulder, while I bore my cross on the Way of Sorrows, a grievous wound which was more painful than the others and which is not recorded by men.'

The traditional prayer in honor of the **shoulder wound of Jesus** calls to mind the wound that Jesus is said to have received carrying the cross on which he was crucified. It is variously attributed to Saint Bernard of Clairvaux.

O most Loving Jesus, Meek Lamb of God, I, a miserable sinner, salute and worship the most Sacred Wound of Thy Shoulder on which thou didst bear Thy heavy cross, which so tore Thy flesh and laid bare Thy Bones as to inflict on Thee an anguish greater than any other wound of Thy Most Blessed Body.

I adore thee, O Jesus most sorrowful; I praise and glorify Thee and give Thee thanks for this most sacred and painful Wound, beseeching Thee by that exceeding pain and by the crushing burden of Thy heavy Cross, to be merciful to me, a sinner, to forgive me all my mortal and venial sins and to lead me on towards Heaven along the Way of Thy Cross. Amen.

We pray that all who are able come to the **Church** on the First Thursday of October to make reparation to the Sacred Wounds of Jesus.
