Epiphany Door Blessing

Bless your house & everyone who enters it! The Epiphany blessing is a simple blessing written on your door as follows: the first two digits of the year + C + M + B + the last two digits of the new year. So, today, it would look like this: 20 + C + M + B + 24.

C M B serves two meanings: The initials of the wise men & the first letters of the Latin phrase: Christus mansionem benedicat (May Christ bless the house).
