Faith & Practice

Today's Gospel shows us that healing does not depend on us, but on God.

Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law at the request of his disciples. After being healed, the woman began to serve out. A real healing leads to action and service...

However, we see that it was not just about physical healing.

Jesus heals in the context of preaching the Gospel. Jesus could perform healings wherever he found hearts open to His teachings.

It is worth asking today what I would ask Jesus for, if he came to my house, just like he came to Peter's house. For example, would I be able to ask for health for my mother-in-law or sister-in-law?

We also need to ask ourselves today how much I believe and accept the teachings of Jesus.

How committed am I as a disciple of Jesus in the Church community?

Or maybe I only want to use the "healing services" of Jesus, but I do not accept His teachings as the norm of my life?
