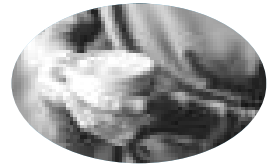

Today I am absolutely THRILLED to share with you that after many discussions with the St. Stanislaus Pastoral Council and parish trustees, a **Catholic Middle School will be moving into the St. Stanislaus School building!**



Founded in 2004, the NativityMiguel Middle School is a faith-based middle school transforming the lives of underserved students in

grades 5-8 through an extended school day program. Currently, both the male and female divisions, St. Augustine and St. Monica, respectively, are located on the old St. James Church campus at Bailey and Kensington.

Their Mission statement explains, *Standing arm-in-arm with our families, NativityMiguel makes a 12-year commitment to our students, starting in middle school and continuing through high school and college. Drawing from four pillars – courage, compassion, community, and contemplation – a NativityMiguel education promotes academic, spiritual, social-emotional, and physical growth, so that our students are inspired to become women and men for others.*

NativityMiguel who will begin the 2025-2026 Academic Year here in September is also closely collaborating with the Polish Saturday School who will retain use of the facilities. Between the Polish Saturday School, the Diaconate Formation Program, and now NativityMiguel, St. Stanislaus is continuing to maximize our facilities in truly becoming an educational campus!

I'm also happy to share with you that we also have **two priests now residing at the St. John Gualbert rectory!** With his work completed in the Office of the Propagation of the Faith, Fr. Justus Ndyamukama has moved to return to his home diocese in Tanzania. We now welcome Fr. David Baker, Vocation Director for the Diocese of Buffalo, and Fr. Christopher Onuoha who is the chaplain at VA Hospital. Both priests moved in earlier this month. Welcome to our Family!
