**Fast** – obligation to fast is from the age of 18 until the beginning of their 60th year. A person may eat one full meal and two smaller meals that together do not equal a full meal. This requirement is for Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

**Abstinence** – obligation to refrain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent.

### **Lent from *The Dynamic Catholic***

When was the last time you had a memorable Lent?  
Or even a life-changing Lent?  
So often we just give up something like chocolate like we always have,  
without giving it much thought.

The purpose of giving something up, of fasting, is to cultivate the inner life. When we fast, it is to realize how truly dependent on God we are. We open our hearts, our minds, and our bodies to God's love in our lives. When we make ourselves available to God, incredible things can happen. That's what can make Lent so powerful.

But don't just give something up, go one step further. There is great value in doing something for Lent. It's the perfect time not only to abandon self-destructive habits, but also to form new life-giving habits.

Below are two lists. One is a list of things to give up for Lent, and the other is a list of life-giving habits.

#### **Things to Give Up For Lent**

##### **Don't eat what you want**

Matthew Kelly talks about the power of never leaving the dinner table without making an act of self-denial. If you want waffles for breakfast, make eggs instead.

##### **Don't interrupt people**

We could probably all do well to spend more time listening, and less time interjecting.

##### **Stop complaining**

Have you ever stopped to think about how many times a day you complain about something or someone? What if you look for the good in people instead of focusing on any inconvenience we experience?

##### **Don't waste downtime**

You don't have to give up social media or the like entirely, but you can be intentional about not using it during specific times. Take that time instead to pray, to breathe, to reach out to someone around you. You'll be amazed at the difference it can make in your day.

#### **Things to Do for Lent**

##### **Spend time in silence**

No habit will change your life more than sitting down with God and spending a few minutes in prayer and reflection.  
Even 10 minutes a day has potential to transform your Lent and your life!

##### **Read the Gospels**

Pick one Gospel – Matthew, Mark, Luke, or John – and read it all the way through during Lent. Just reading for 10 or 15 minutes and pray to hear what the Spirit is saying to you.  
Jesus is not just a historical figure. He is alive and with us in everything we do.

##### **Almsgiving**

From the book of Tobit:

*Prayer with fasting is good. Almsgiving with righteousness is better than wealth with wickedness. It is better to give alms than to store up gold,  
for almsgiving saves from death and purges all sin. Those who give alms will enjoy a full life, but those who commit sin and do evil are their own worst enemies.*

##### **Create a Holy Moment everyday**

Send a kind note to a loved one, do a good deed for a stranger. Visit a shut in or call someone who might be lonely.

Text a kind or inspirational word to a friend.

Tell someone who you love that you love them.

Tell Jesus that you love Him and thank Him for dying for your sins!

## Why Ashes? *By Fr. Larry Rice*

For centuries, Catholic Christians have marked the beginning of the season of Lent by receiving ash on their foreheads on Ash Wednesday. This tradition has its roots in the Old Testament, where wearing ashes was a common sign of repentance for sins, and a sign of one's humility before God. Since Lent is a season of penitential renewal through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, it's appropriate that this ancient sign marks the beginning of the season.

The ashes themselves are usually made by burning the palm fronds from the previous year's Palm Sunday. This symbolically connects the beginning of Lent with its end, connecting our change of heart with Christ's passion, death, and resurrection.

Ashes are usually distributed as part of the Mass on Ash Wednesday, of-



ten after the homily. As people approach the priest or other minister, he presses the ashes to their foreheads, and speaks one of two phrases: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return,"

or "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

In many places, Ash Wednesday services are among the most popular of the whole year—a day that's not even a Holy Day of Obligation. Cynics have suggested that this is because people "get" something, as they do on Palm Sunday. But there's nothing particularly appealing about getting smudged with ashes. Perhaps, the appeal is the ex-pression through a physical sign of a desire for interior conversion.

The Gospel for Ash Wednesday is a reminder that the real purpose of the season of Lent isn't to make public demonstrations of piety—even the wearing of ashes—but to seek conversion of heart.
