**Four Indulgences Perfect for Lent**  
*(according to the National Catholic Register)*

**The first indulgent work is the Stations of the Cross.** It's a centuries-old way to remember and meditate on Our Lord's Passion and Death. Every church should have the Stations of the Cross in some form. Some are simple, some quite elaborate. All are legitimate. For the Way of the Cross, there must be 14 stations representing the 14 stations of Jerusalem.

**The second prescribed work is the Holy Rosary.** *"Devoutly recite the Marian Rosary in a church or oratory, or in a family, a religious community, or an association of the faithful, and in general when several of the faithful gather for some honest purpose,"* states the manual of the basic ways. The first three are most applicable for everyone for Lent: in a church, or an oratory, or in a family. Families saying the Rosary together are wonderful Lenten practice. The manual does remind the five-decade rosary is sufficient but all five decades must be done without interruption.

**The third work is Eucharistic Adoration.** Visit the Blessed Sacrament for adoration lasting at least a half hour.

**The fourth work is reading or listening to Sacred Scriptures.** Read the Sacred Scriptures as spiritual reading, from a text approved by a competent authority, and with the reverence due to the divine word, for at least a half an hour; if the time is less, the indulgence will be partial. Or if you're unable to read it, you can listen to it being read.

**The Three Necessary Conditions**  
There are three necessary conditions for receiving a plenary indulgence for doing any of the prescribed works we just learned. Each one is this trinity of conditions also has the bonus of adding to our Lenten journey. They are:

Sacramentally confess your sins, if needed.  
Receive Holy Communion.  
Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.  
Actually, there is one more: You must have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin.

**From Fr. Cole Webster**

We have been through a lot as a Family of Parishes which, I believe, has brought us all closer to God and one another. **St. John Kanty, St. John Gualbert, St. Adalbert and St. Stanislaus** have merged together to form a new community. The pain of closing our **St. John Kanty** worship site continues to be felt by us all. For the past year and a half **St. John Gualbert** was on the Diocesan watchlist and has since been removed after a long and hard look at their finances and fundraising initiatives. **St. Katharine Drexel** continues on the Diocesan watchlist while actively offering many opportunities for spiritual growth focusing on financial sustainability. This past year, there has also been a transition with the Pauline Order at **Corpus Christi** as we said “Goodbye” to Fr. Mark and welcomed Fr. Jacek. Currently, we will soon be entering into the thick of reviewing the finances at our **St. Stanislaus** worship site in order to balance the budget.

All of us have felt growing pains, but most importantly we are making progress and our **St. Adalbert** worship site has not been excluded. For decades the pastors, parishioners, and the Diocese have referred to St. Adalbert's as a basilica, but during the Journey of Faith and Grace in the mid-2000s the Diocese claimed there was uncertainty surrounding their “basilica” status. Tasked with obtaining the truth so that we could move forward together with mutual understanding, I asked Bishop Fisher to send a *dubium* (a ‘yes’ or ‘no’ clarification) to the Congregation for the Clergy in Rome. The response that we received is that the church is affiliated with St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome to benefit from spiritual indulgences, but this is not in itself an elevation to minor basilica status. While many will likely continue to refer colloquially to ‘St. Adalbert’s Basilica’ we can begin this new chapter with a mutual understanding of the truth and in love and respect for God and one another, and pursue the spiritual indulgences St. Adalbert's affiliation with a major basilica in Rome affords.


