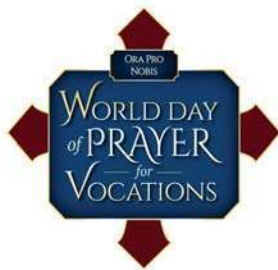

**ST. PAUL CENTER  
FOR BIBLICAL THEOLOGY**

**The Blessed Path**

In the readings since Christmas, Jesus has been revealed as the new royal son of David and Son of God. He is sent to lead a new exodus that brings Israel out of captivity to the nations and brings all the nations to God.

As Moses led Israel from Egypt through the sea to give them God's law on Mount Sinai, Jesus too has passed through the waters in baptism. Now, in today's Gospel, He goes to the mountain to proclaim a new law - the law of His Kingdom. The Beatitudes mark the fulfillment of God's covenant promise to Abraham - that through his descendants all the nations of the world would receive God's blessings (see Genesis 12:3; 22:18).

Jesus is the son of Abraham (see Matthew 1:1). And through the wisdom He speaks today, He bestows the Father's blessings upon "the poor in spirit." God has chosen to bless the weak and lowly, those foolish and despised in the eyes of the world, Paul says in today's Epistle. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit God's mercy and grace. These are the humble remnant in today's First Reading - taught to seek refuge in the name of the Lord.

The Beatitudes reveal the divine path and purpose for our lives. All our striving should be for these virtues - to be poor in spirit; meek and clean of heart; merciful and makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that comes from living by the law of Kingdom. The path the Lord sets before us today is one of trials and persecution. But He promises comfort in our mourning and a great reward.

The Kingdom we have inherited is no earthly territory, but the promised land of heaven. It is Zion where the Lord reigns forever. And, as we sing in today's Psalm, its blessings are for those whose hope is in the Lord.

## Crowning of Mary May 3, 9:15 am

What is May Crowning, and why do we do it? May Crowning is a ritual celebrated in the month of May where an image or statue of Mary is crowned with a wreath of flowers and honored as the Queen of Heaven and the Mother of God. The Crowning can be celebrated at any time during the month of May. There is no set day or ritual, but traditionally May Crownings are celebrated after a Mass on that day. After a procession, usually a crown of flowers is placed on the head of a statue of Mary. It's followed by prayers and/or hymns centered around Mary. May has been Mary's month since the medieval times. Mary was a perfect follower of Christ, and so is considered the crown of creation. She is also the Mother of the Son of God, Jesus, who is the King of Israel and the universe. And of course, she is the most important woman in our faith, and our spiritual mother. We hope you will join us in honoring our spiritual mother, Mary!

## St. Louis-Marie Grignon de Montfort, SMM

St. Louis de Montfort was a French Catholic priest born in January of 1673 and died, April 28, 1716.

He is greatly known for his influence on Catholic Mariology being the author of “*The Secret of the Rosary*” and “*True Devotion to Mary*”. Montfort also had great veneration for angels. He would “*urge his confreres to show marks of respect and tenderness to their guardian angels,*” and would end his letters with a salutation to the guardian angel of the person to whom he was writing. His book, “*True Devotion*”, is about totally consecrating oneself to Jesus through Mary. His reason for going to Jesus through Mary is because, “*of all creatures, Mary is the one most conformed to Jesus Christ, it follows that among all devotions that which most consecrates and conforms a soul to our Lord is devotion to Mary, His Holy Mother, and that the more a soul is consecrated to her the more will it be consecrated to Jesus Christ.*”

What does it mean to be consecrated to Mary? When one consecrates himself to the Blessed Virgin Mary, he promises to become dependent on her in ALL things: to offer all his/her prayers and oblations to God through Mary, and to seek every gift from God through Mary. Since Mary is our mother, she knows our needs better than we do, and since she is Queen of Heaven, she has immediate access to the infinite treasury of graces in the Kingdom of her Divine Son.

## A Consecration Prayer of St. Louis de Montfort

***“Today, I, \_\_\_\_\_,  
a faithless sinner,  
renew in your hands my Baptismal vows;  
I renounce Satan forever,  
his prompts and works;  
and I give myself entirely to Jesus Christ  
the Incarnate Wisdom,  
and will carry my cross after Him  
all the days of my life  
and will be more faithful to Him  
than I have ever been.  
With the entire heavenly court as my  
witness,  
I choose you this day for my Mother.  
I deliver and consecrate myself to you,***

*my body and soul,  
myself, both interior and exterior,  
and the worth of my good actions,  
past, present and future;  
leaving to you the total right  
of disposing of me,  
and all that belongs to me,  
according to your wish,  
for the greater glory of God  
in time and eternity.  
Amen.”*
