Mass for the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The Queen of Peace Chapel (convent)
at 8:45 am. Blessing of Flowers, Herbs,
and Fruits of the Garden follows.

Placing flowers at the feet of a statue, icon, or picture of the Blessed Mother whether in a church, shrine, or home altar, is a cherished tradition expressing love, devotion, and gratitude to the Mother of God.

As we present our Blessed Mother with flowers, it is meaningful to address Mary with sentiments of the heart expressing our gratitude to her, for not only being the Mother of our Lord, Jesus Christ, but also, for being our Mother. Telling her how grateful we are for all the times she prayed with us and for us!

Marian Flowers and their meanings:

Roses: Known as the “*Mystical Rose*,” roses symbolize Mary’s purity, love, and sorrow. White roses represent her purity and joy.

Red roses represent her love of God and the sorrows she sacrificed.

Yellow roses represent her glories and her friendship towards the people of God.

Pink roses symbolize her sweetness and our admiration and gratitude for her “fiat”!

Lilies: Because the Blessed Mother was immaculately conceived, created without original sin, lilies signify Mary’s purity and her sinlessness.

Violets: The Violet is traditionally referred to as “*Our Lady’s Modesty*”. The delicate and unassuming nature of the violet reflects Mary’s gentle and humble character symbolizing not only Mary’s modesty but also her humility. Legend has it that violets

bloomed when Mary responded to the Angel Gabriel at the Annunciation, saying, “*Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. Be it done unto me according to Thy word.*”
Marigolds: often referred to as, “*Mary’s Gold*”. This flower represents Mary’s golden heart and the queenship of Mary.

Iris: This flower represents the Sorrows of our Blessed Mother. The blade-shaped leaves represent the seven swords that pierced her immaculate heart.

Daisy: The Daisy is used to symbolize beauty, love, fertility, along with motherhood, childbirth, and new beginnings.

Our Blessed Lady is not only the Mother of God, the Mother of Jesus, but she is the New Eve, the Mother of Man kind! Through Mary’s, “yes,” the world experienced a “*new beginning*,” when Mary said, “Yes” to God at the Annunciation!

*O how wondrous is the dignity

She merited to become the mother of Him

and the grandeur of all the Saints.
Mary was the seat of our sanctification,

Sinking Fear

How do we find God in the storms and struggles of our lives, in the trials we encounter in trying to do His will?

God commands Elijah in today's First Reading to stand on the mountain and await His passing by. And in the Gospel, Jesus makes the disciples set out across the waters to meet Him.

In each case, the Lord makes himself present amid frightening tumult - heavy winds and high waves, fire and earthquakes.

Elijah hides his face. Perhaps he remembers Moses, who met God on the same mountain, also amid fire, thunder, and smoke (see Deuteronomy 4:10-15; Exodus 19:17-19). God told Moses no one could see His face and live, and He sheltered Moses in the hollow of a rock, as He shelters Elijah in a cave (see Exodus 33:18-23).

The disciples, likewise, are too terrified to look on the face of God. Today's Gospel is a revelation of Jesus' divine identity. Only God treads across the crest of the sea (see Job 9:8) and rules the raging waters (see Psalm 89:9-10). And the words of assurance that Jesus speaks - "It is I" - are those God used to identify himself to Moses (see Exodus 3:14; Isaiah 43:10).

Even Peter is too overcome by fear to imitate his Lord. His fears, Jesus tells him, are a sign of his lack of faith. And so it often is with us. Our fears make us doubt, make it hard to see His glory dwelling in our midst.

Yet, we should know, as we sing in today's psalm, that His salvation is near to those who hope in Him. By faith we should know, as Paul asserts in today's Epistle, that we are heirs to the promises made to His children, Israel.

We must trust that He whispers to us in the trials of our lives - that He who has called us to walk along the way of His steps, will save us whenever we begin to sink.

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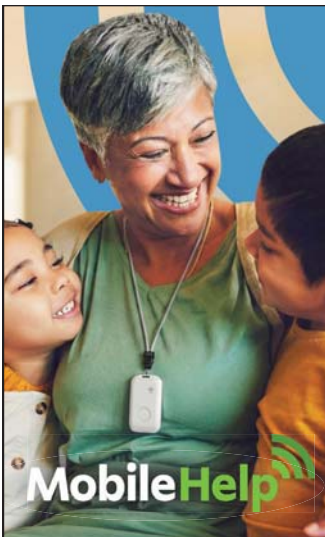
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
