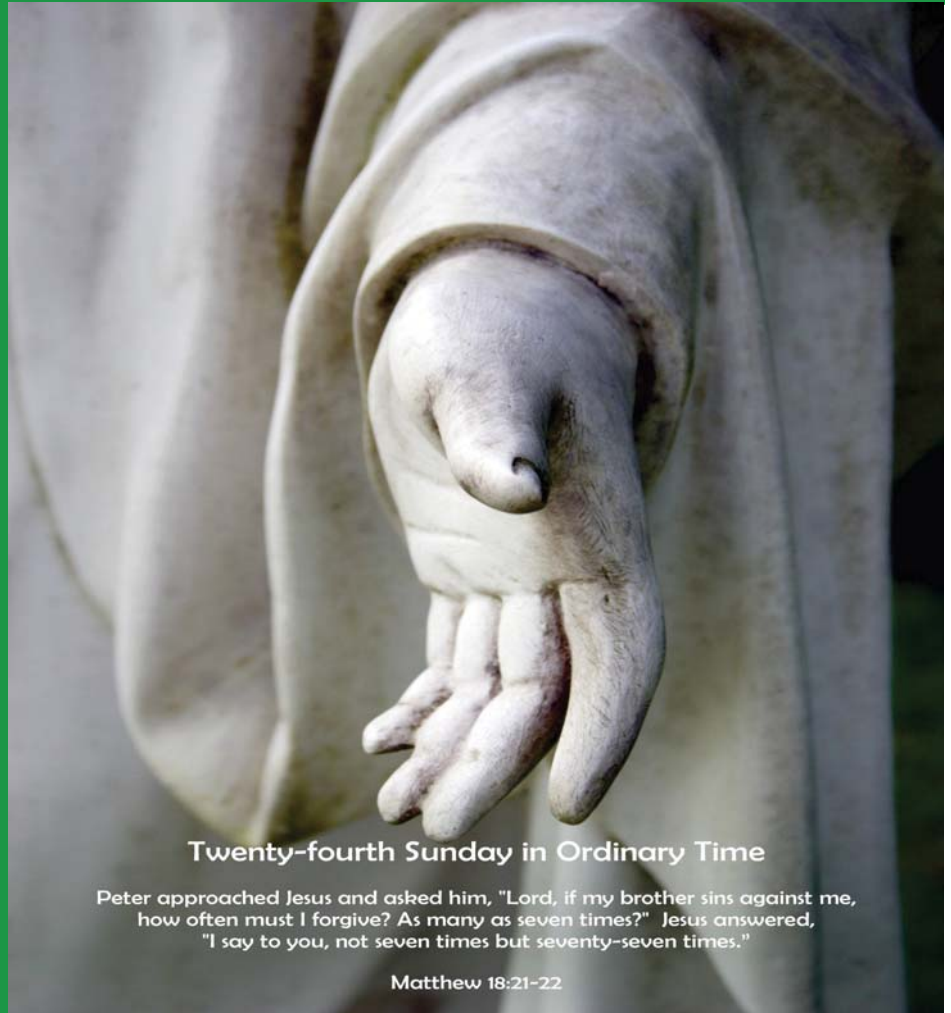

Truly, we know Corpus Christi is a special place, a faith community which offers deeply meaningful and reverent liturgies, in a setting steeped in tradition. We are grateful to the Pauline Fathers who continue to serve and lead us in our faith journey. Let’s all work to get the word out to others about this special place! Please always take (or make) the opportunity to welcome & invite others to join us for Holy Mass!

Our Finance Council, in concert with PC and Friends of Corpus Christi representatives, have begun a comprehensive examination of the financial situation of our Parish. This includes an objective, in-depth look at all current assets, income, expenses, and projected expenses. Exploring options for decreasing expenses while increasing revenue is a key aspect as well. It is our intention that a formal report will be presented to our Parish community by October. We kindly ask that you keep us in prayer as we continue our work on this important project.

Active Shooter/Safety Awareness training was very informative! The presentation focused on the Department of Homeland Security’s “Run, Hide, Fight” initiative. Relevant posters are in our Church, and we hope to repeat the training for our Family of Parishes in the future. We have also received resources to help us be prepared for addressing issues of concern should they arise.

Precepts of the Catholic Church from Catechism of the Catholic Church

(2041, 2042, 2043)

The **first precept**, (“*You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation.*”) requires the faithful to participate in the Eucharistic celebration when the Christian community gathers on the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord.

Missing Mass on Sunday without a serious reason – illness, caring for a dependent, an emergency is considered grave matter.

The **second precept**, (“*You shall confess your sins at least once a year.*”) ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism’s work of conversion and forgiveness.

The **third precept**, (“*You shall humbly receive your Creator in Holy Communion at least during the Easter season.*”) guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord’s Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy.

The **fourth precept**, (“*You shall keep holy the holy days of obligation.*”) completes the Sunday observance by participation in the principal liturgical feasts which honor the mysteries of the Lord, the Virgin Mary, and the saints.

The **fifth precept**, (“*You shall observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence.*”) ensures the times of asceticism and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts; they help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart.

The faithful also have the duty of providing for the material needs of the Church, each according to his abilities.
