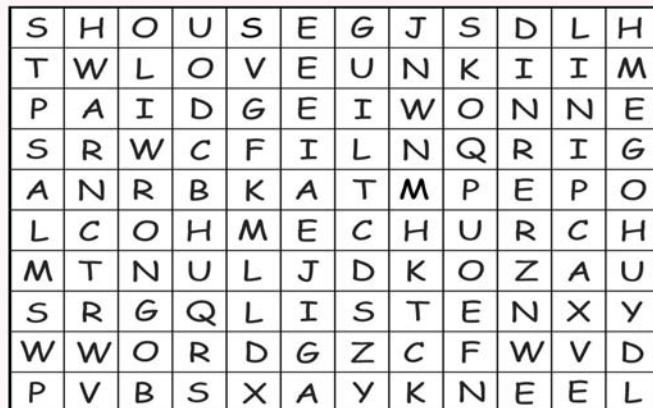

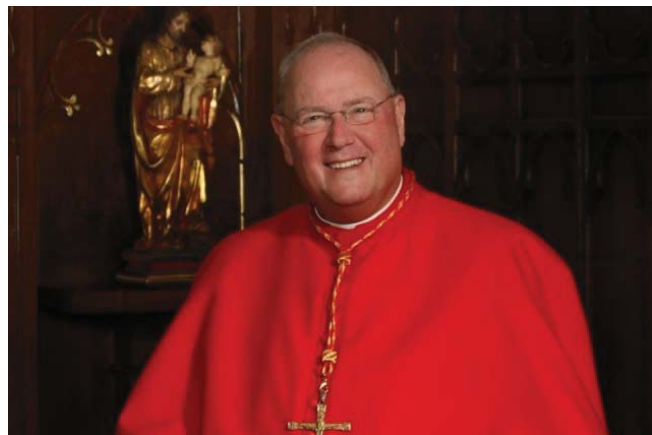

is the feast of the *Holy Name of Mary*.

How this feast came about is due to the victory over the Turkish invaders from the Ottoman Empire by John III Sobieski, King of Poland.

Sobieski had great devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Despite the situation not in his favor, his devotion to Mary gave him courage to meet the challenge.

On the way to battle, under a banner of Our Lady, Sobieski and his troops stopped to pray for Mary's assistance at her shrine in Czestochowa. At that time, Pope Innocent XI also requested that the Rosary be prayed for the defense of Christian Europe.

Sobieski's words before battle, *Let us march with confidence under the protection of Heaven and with the aid of the Most Holy Virgin!*

The feast, of course, is not all about celebrating a victory in one battle. But it surely can teach us to call on Mary in all our battles, beginning with the spiritual ones.

St. Alphonsus Liguori in his book *The Glories of Mary* said, *After the most sacred name of Jesus, the name of Mary is so rich in every good thing, that on earth and in heaven there is no other from which devout souls receive so much grace, hope, and sweetness.*

St. Bonaventure agrees: *As wax melts before fire, so do the devils fear her so much that on hearing her name they fly as from a burning fire.*

Exaltation of the Holy Cross

When we honor, or exalt, the Cross, Christians are primarily acknowledging Christ Himself (2nd Council of Nicaea).

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states,
The Council of Trent emphasizes the unique character of Christ's sacrifice as "the source of eternal salvation" and teaches that "his most holy Passion on the wood of the cross merited justification for us." And the Church venerates his cross as she sings: "Hail, O Cross, our only hope" (CCC 617).

Why do we celebrate the Exaltation of the Holy Cross?

As well as celebrating the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross commemorates two historical events.

The first is the discovery in 320 AD of the True Cross, of Calvary, and of the tomb of Christ by St. Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine, which the Romans had buried under a Temple to Venus.

The second is the dedication of a church on the site in 335 AD. Today this church, in continuous existence since then, is known as the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher, and houses the Calvary, the Tomb of Jesus, and the cistern in which St. Helena found the instruments of the Passion, including the Cross.

What does INRI on crucifixes mean?

The Latin initials INRI represent *Iesus Nazarenus Rex Iudaeorum* (Jesus of Nazareth King of the Jews).

In keeping with Roman crucifixion practices, Pilate had Christ's name and "crime against Rome" nailed to the cross as a warning to others. This title was among the items St. Helena discovered in Jerusalem, and it is preserved along with other relics of the Passion in the Church of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem in Rome.
